Abdul Ghafoor Mohamed

Ambassador of Maldives to the United States of America

Abdul Ghafoor Mohamed was appointed as Ambassador of the Maldives to the United States of America by President Ibrahim Mohamed Solih on 15 September 2022 and presented his credentials to President Joseph Biden on 12 December 2022. He had formerly served as Foreign Secretary since November 2018 and as Ambassador-at-Large since May 2022.

An accomplished diplomat, Ghafoor has served the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Maldives, both at headquarters and in a number of foreign postings. Starting his career as a Program Officer in 1983, he has held the post of Assistant Undersecretary, Assistant Director, Political Affairs and Deputy Director and Director, Foreign Relations, at the Ministry. In 1997, Ghafoor was deputed to serve in the Secretariat of South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC) as Director from Maldives. Following his 3-year tenure at the SAARC Secretariat, Ghafoor was appointed Director General at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 2000 and was later promoted to the rank of Assistant Executive Director in 2005 and then to Executive Director in 2007.

During his long and distinguished career in the Maldives foreign service, Ghafoor also served as Counsellor and then Deputy High Commissioner of Maldives to Sri Lanka and later as Deputy High Commissioner of Maldives to Malaysia. He was appointed as the Permanent Representative of the Maldives to the United Nations Offices in Geneva in 2008 by then President Maumoon Abdul Gayoom, concurrently serving as the Permanent Representative of Maldives to the World Trade Organisation. Following the change of Government in 2008, the newly elected President Mohamed Nasheed appointed Ghafoor as the Permanent Representative of Maldives to the United Nations in 2009, concurrently accredited as the Ambassador to the United States of America and Non-Resident High Commissioner to Canada. After the unprecedented and controversial resignation of President Nasheed in 2012, Ghafoor stepped down from his post.

From 2013 till 2014, Ghafoor served as a Consultant at the Foreign Relations Department of the People's Majlis (Parliament), aiding the legislature in fostering international cooperation and engagement. During the period 2014-2017, Ghafoor served as Director, Special Projects at ADK Enterprises Pvt Ltd, and as the Head of External Relations at the newly established Tree Top Hospital in Hulhumale', gaining experience in the private sector. An individual with a keenness for academia, Ghafoor also lectured at the Maldives National University from 2016 to 2018 in the subjects of Political Science and International Relations.

Ghafoor graduated from the University of Tasmania, Australia, in 1984 with a B.A(Hons.) in Political Science and was awarded an M.A in International Relations from the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy, Tufts University, USA in 1988.

Born on 20 November 1959, Ghafoor is married to Mariyam Khalida. They have a son and a daughter.

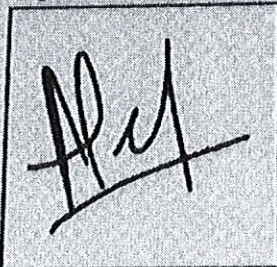

**HER EXCELLENCY AISHATH SHAAN SHAKIR,
AMBASSADOR OF MALDIVES TO GERMANY**

A BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE



Her Excellency Aishath Shaan Shakir began her career in the Maldives public service in 1984 at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, after she completed her General Certificate of Education (GCE) O' Levels.

During her long tenure Her Excellency Shaan has immensely contributed to the Foreign Service of Maldives by promoting foreign policy interests of the Maldives both abroad and at home. She has wide exposure in several different work areas of the Ministry, most notably in the Protocol Department. She worked her way from the rank of Protocol Officer to the rank of Deputy Chief of Protocol and accompanied the President of Maldives on official visits to the United Kingdom, Republic of Korea and Bhutan (2010 – 2012) and as the Chief of Protocol accompanied the President on State Visits and Official visits to Bangladesh, Qatar, United Arab Emirates, 76th UNGA, COP26 (2021 - 2022).

Her Excellency Shaan has attended a seminar on Chinese language for government officials from developing countries and undergone training in International Relations and Diplomacy.

In early 2011, she was appointed as the Deputy Ambassador to Saudi Arabia, and later served as the Deputy High Commissioner to Malaysia until 2014. During her tenure as the Deputy High Commissioner, she served as the Head of Chancery, overseeing the broad mandate of promoting and strengthening the bilateral relations between the Maldives and Malaysia and looking after the consular affairs of the mission that addressed the issues faced by Maldivians residing and visiting Malaysia.

In late 2014, Her Excellency Shaan returned to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs as Joint Secretary, in-charge of the Consular Services Department, overseeing all consular issues faced by Maldivians living abroad and facilitation of visas to Maldivians travelling abroad.

As part of her responsibilities, Her Excellency Shaan also maintains close contact with the resident diplomatic missions of other countries in the Maldives on a regular basis.

From December 2016 to October 2020 Her Excellency Shaan served as the Ambassador/High Commissioner of Maldives to Bangladesh. She was appointed as the Chief of Protocol in November 2020, the position in which she has been serving till she was appointed as the Ambassador of Maldives to Germany on 20th July 2022. She presented her credentials to the President of Germany on 22nd of August 2022.

Her Excellency Shaan is also appointed as the non-resident Ambassador of Maldives to Denmark, Finland, Norway, Russia, Sweden and Ukraine. She presented her Letter of Credence to His Majesty King Harald V, King of Norway 26th January 2023.

In the first year, I was also performing the duties of a Deputy Chief of Mission while being in-charge of the Administration and Finance Section, Political Affairs Section together with Protocol Section. Two diplomatic home-based staff and 16 local staff directly reported to me daily and assisted in the smooth running of the Mission.

- August 2007 – The Ministry opened the Embassy of Maldives in China and was posted to Beijing. Played an active role in the establishment of the Mission as Second Secretary and the only diplomatic home-based staff then, apart from the Ambassador. During the tenure in Beijing gained experience in hiring locals for different posts required for the Embassy; and at the same time without hesitation took difficult decisions when letting go of some of those locals, based on their performance. Hence, in Beijing Mission by the time the tenure of 03 years was completed, four locals and one additional home-based staff had worked under direct supervision while in-charge of the Administration and Finance as well as the Political Affairs section.
- Upon completion of tenure in Beijing, had returned to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and was in-charge of the International Organisations and Conferences Department. Looked after multilateral issues and 06 subordinates directly reported on a daily basis. Subsequently, played a major part in positively changing the image of the Consular Affairs Department for two years; where motivationally led a team of 06 subordinates.
- 2006 – Permanent Mission of Maldives to the United Nations. Looked after agendas related to economic and social development, human rights and humanitarian affairs. Thus, followed the Second and Third Committees of the General Assembly. Prior to this, even in 1994 was a member of the Maldives delegation which attended the UNGA. In 1994, looked after Sixth Committee and Third Committee related issues.

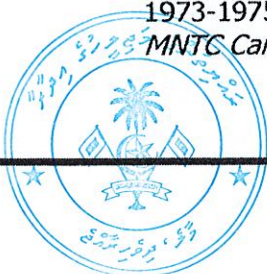

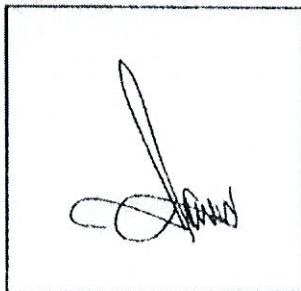

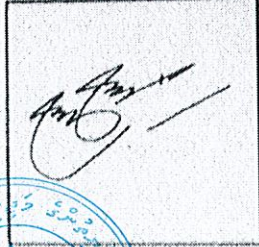
