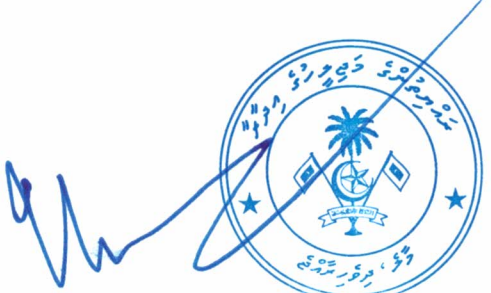

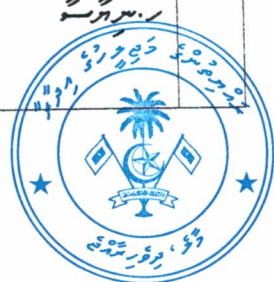

- In 2014 posted as Counsellor in Delhi Mission. During the tenure in Delhi Mission, the dedication and tireless performance prompted the High Commissioner of Maldives to India then to advocate on my behalf and promoted from the rank of Counsellor to Minister-Counsellor; within a short period of eleven months into the posting. In the first year, I was also performing the duties of a Deputy Chief of Mission while being in-charge of the Administration and Finance Section, Political Affairs Section together with Protocol Section. Two diplomatic home-based staff and 16 local staff directly reported to me daily and assisted in the smooth running of the Mission.



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- August 2007 – The Ministry opened the Embassy of Maldives in China and was posted to Beijing. Played an active role in the establishment of the Mission as Second Secretary and the only diplomatic home-based staff then, apart from the Ambassador. During the tenure in Beijing gained experience in hiring locals for different posts required for the Embassy; and at the same time without hesitation took difficult decisions when letting go of some of those locals, based on their performance. Hence, in Beijing Mission by the time the tenure of 03 years was completed, four locals and one additional home-based staff had worked under direct supervision while in-charge of the Administration and Finance as well as the Political Affairs section.
 - Upon completion of tenure in Beijing, had returned to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and was in-charge of the International Organisations and Conferences Department. Looked after multilateral issues and 06 subordinates directly reported on a daily basis. Subsequently, played a major part in positively changing the image of the Consular Affairs Department for two years; where motivationally led a team of 06 subordinates.

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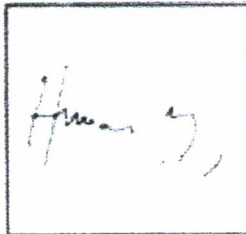

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BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Asim Ahmed, Ph.D

Dr. Asim Ahmed began his career in public service over thirty years ago in 1985 at the former Ministry of Planning and National Development, Maldives. During that time, he rose rapidly through the ranks to become Director, Strategic Planning and contributed extensively in the area of planning and national development, both in the government and in collaboration with civil society organisations and international agencies.

Following the advent of multi-party politics in the Maldives, Dr. Asim Ahmed has been closely involved in the country's democratic journey. As the Head of the Jumhooree Party Foreign Relations Committee he was an active member of the Joint Foreign Relations Committee led by the Maldivian Democratic Party. Since March 2019 he has been serving as Ambassador-at-Large at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. In that capacity he addressed the 74th Session of the UN General Assembly in New York in 2019, and the 43rd Session of the UN Human Rights Council in Geneva in 2020, highlighting the Government's democratic ideals and commitment to multilateralism.

From 2011-2013, Dr. Asim served as the Minister of Education. During this time the President also appointed him periodically as the Acting Minister of Foreign Affairs and for a time as the Acting Minister of Tourism. In 2012, Dr. Asim was elected as the President of the Local Government Authority (LGA). He served on a number of boards, committees and high-level councils including the National Security Council. As the Minister of Education, he also served as the President of the Maldives UNESCO National Commission. He was also appointed as the President of the National Higher Education Council.

Professionally, Dr. Asim has provided technical consultancies in a wide range of social and economic areas to a number of international agencies including UNDP, UNICEF, UNESCAP and UNFPA. In 1991 he worked as a consultant at the ILO Head Office in Geneva. During the initial phase of the reconstruction of Afghanistan, he worked as a consultant in the UNICEF Country Office in Kabul from 2002 to 2004. Some of his professional work has been published by ILO, UNESCAP and UNFPA.

He completed a Bachelor of Arts degree (B.A) in Sociology and Politics at the University of South Pacific, Fiji, in 1989. In 1992 he completed the degree of Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) in Development Studies at the Institute of Development Studies (IDS) at the University of Sussex, UK. He was awarded the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in social policy by Victoria University of Wellington, New Zealand in 2011.

In 1989 he achieved the Gold Medal in Social Science for Academic Excellence and the Vice Chancellor's Prize for Best All-round Performance from the University of the South Pacific. In recognition of his academic achievements he was awarded the President's Prize by the Government of Maldives in 1989 and in 2012. While he served as the Education Minister Dr. Asim Ahmed received the Award for Outstanding Contribution to Education from the World Education Congress, Mumbai, India, in 2013.

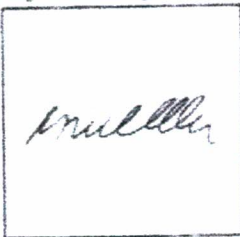
